



### Education Worker

Domestic abuse is always unacceptable. Behind Closed Doors supports everyone affected by it and we act to prevent it. We are there at the point of crisis working with individuals and families in communities, and we stay on to offer support through recovery. We deliver training, awareness sessions and workshops in communities, organisations and educational settings to promote our preventive message.

We are looking to appoint an Education Worker to support the Behind Closed Doors team to design and deliver Healthy Relationships workshops with girls and young women. Working closely with LS-Ten, this work will be delivered in partnership with the Alternative Education Providers in Leeds.

This role will be working closely with our Prevention and Recovery Team and supported by the Supervisor.

### Main Duties and Responsibilities

- Establish positive relationship with young people and those within the community.
- Assess the needs and support individuals and groups within a variety of settings.
- Be a positive role model for those within the local community (lead by example).
- Deliver a creative and engaging programme of workshops, covering areas such as: confidence and aspirations; healthy relationships; life skills development and emotional literacy.
- Build relationships and work effectively with education providers in Leeds.
- Regularly monitor and review the quality of the work that we deliver; and write any required reports.
- Attend training and development opportunities, maintain an up-to-date knowledge of Safeguarding, Health and Safety and GDPR.
- Support other team members in their roles as sessional workers, volunteers, or young leaders.
- Carry out other tasks as directed from time to time, according to the needs of the project.
